


Why did I like that video?

Why did I go for asynchronous learning?

- Convenience is not a marginal issue!
- Different pace
- Time-zones
- Synchronous meetings are culturally unaware
- Asynchronous learning promotes deeper reflection

"I like not feeling pressured to communicate right away – I like to have processing time and feel as though I can come back to the conversation later and still participate. It helps me to be more thoughtful."

"Asynchronous communication links with my local time, my skills, my preferences, my interests, my agenda. So it is focused on ME"

"I enjoy reading and reflecting; turning things over in my own mind before contributing; being able to stop, walk away, look something up, before responding."

Students are stressed!

- Be available
- Connect
 - Instructor introduction video
 - Icebreakers
 - Question of the day activity
- Use fun activities to engage students

Students are confused!

- Communicate Send weekly emails and explain all the tasks they have in that week.
- Don't spam them!
- Organize your course in weekly Canvas modules.
- Use Canvas discussion

Students have too much work to do!

- Credit hour policy
- Estimate time required for each activity
- Talk to the other faculty members
